TIME SCHEDULE FOR OPTIONAL SITE VISIT PROGRAMME

08.30 hrs: assemble & board bus(es) at Kinmel Bay Church carpark

08.45-10.45 hrs: visits to Towyn Sea Defences (with highest spring tides on view), Foryd Harbour development, Clwyd river embankments, three proposed 2-storey refuge sites. Return to Kinmel Bay Church (one of these).

11.00-12.15 hrs: coffee, viewing of exhibits, and informal networking centred on talks by Andy Parsons of Halcrow on the two Shoreline Management Plan proposals affecting North Wales, and Mr Franco Patricolo of Capita Symonds on the West Kirby Marine Lake as a coastal adaptation model relevant to future coastally attached tidal lagoons.

12.15.-12.45 hrs: lunch

12.45-13.45 hrs: proceed by bus to Llandudno Town Hall via Colwyn Bay & Rhos seafront, and (if time) a circuit of the Great Orme

14.00 hrs: start of seminar (as in other box). Bus-travelling delegates will have front places reserved.
